Knitting Pattern

You will need:

Yellow wool, brown wool, a safety pin

Abbreviations used:

Stitch / Stitches = st / sts

Slip a stitch = sl

Knit = k

Pass slip stitch over = pss0

Left hand needle = LH

Right hand needle = RH

Increase = Inc



Cast on 6 sts in yellow

Row 1: Cast off 4 stitches, transfer stitch on RH to LH

Row 2: Inc in 1st st then 4 by going between sts. Cast off these 4 sts, transfer st on RH to LH.

Repeat until there are 19 sts on LH

k3 rows in yellow.

Break off yellow, leaving small tail.

Join on brown. k4 rows.

Next row: k1, (sl1, pss0, k1) until end of row, k1 (13sts)

Next row: k

Next row: k1 (sl1, pss0) to end of row.

Break off brown leaving long tail, thread through sts and pull up tight.

Use tail to join brown seam and sew safety pin across centre.

Use yellow tails to join petals and trim in ends.

Pattern uses UK crochet terms:

Slip stitch

Sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

Htr – half treble

Dtr- double treble
